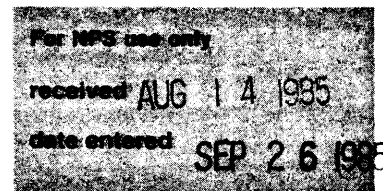

4. Owner: Joseph Schufle, 1301 8th, Las Vegas, N.M.

7. Description: Decorative chimney; asphalt shingle roof; moderate to large eave overhang with exposed rafters; curvilinear parapets with projecting cap; curvilinear windows with stuttered reveal in gables; 12/1, 15/1 double-hung windows; single door and casement window framed by Composite pilasters and entablature with dentils; porch arches.

This frame stucco house stands across from St. Anthony's Hospital, one block north of the North New Town Residential District.

Addition of greenhouse to rear corner detracts little from its original appearance.

8. Significance: Built about 1905, this was long the home for C.W.G. Ward, District Attorney for the Fourth District of New Mexico. It is a quality example of the Mission Style with details like its chimney and gable windows (the horizontal section of the chimney is similar to window's shape), and in the handling of the parapet walls which project beyond the intersecting walls.
