This public library branch was built with the aid of an \$8,000 grant from the Carnegie Foundation, and was part of a total grant of \$38,000. The branch was specifically built for "the colored citizens" after a group of black Methodists requested such a library. It is believed that Meridian was the only city ever given a black library by Carnegie as a part of an original grant. The church that originally requested the library donated the site to the city, but upon the closing of the branch in 1974, the property reverted to the Methodist Church.
