



ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

Two-story stone-sheathed structure on raised basement of giant, rusticated concrete blocks. The dominant feature is the peristyle of fluted Ionic columns, which supports a full classical entablature. The tall parapet is crowned by a cresting of anthemions, and a step over the center entrance has a very large palmette that serves as a finial. A monumental staircase rises to the three-bay entrance, each bay having a denticulated cornice with corner consoles.

ALTERATIONS:

Original windows have been replaced; basement entrances on side facades altered.

Front lawn contains a fountain and reflecting pool; spacious rear lawn has been paved for parking.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

This is quite an outstanding municipal building for a city of Meridian's size (about 30,000 at the time of the building's completion). It is the only example of its style in the area.
