18 continued : Double window in gambrel front; gable end above has box cornice with return, square and imbricated shingles, horseshoe shaped inset with pendant, and diamond shaped window. South facade has same gable trim above a bay window. Corbeled brick chimney at joint of S&E gable portions. North facade has imbricated and square shingles on gambrel face, same decoration in gable end. Stained glass window. West facade has same decoration, 3 bay open porch with turned posts, machine cut trim. Rear door. Interior--door trim with corner blocks and tracery, mantels have tile facing around fireplace.
