DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE Built by Charles Patnude in 1893 for \$2,000.00, the two-story frame house at 1239 Eighth Avenue in Olympia, Washington, is an interesting combination of roof forms and exterior ornamentation. Originally the house stood on a double lot until 1924 when the property was divided. The foundation is of brick, probably manufactured at the builder's own kiln in Olympia.

Multiple gables and round-arched window mouldings on the second floor are Gothic influences. However, the L-shaped front porch on the north side, as well as the back porch and bay windows, all have Mansard roofs. Three square bay windows are located off the front parlor on the north and east and adjoining the living room on the west. Most notable on the exterior is the scalloped wood trim which decorates a broad frieze below the boxed eaves. Another scallop motif ornaments the bay windows and the porches at the front and rear. Additionally, a sawtooth moulding along the porch frieze forms unusual fan brackets at the top of each turned porch post. Small pendants hang from the center of the spaces between posts.

The interior of the house is remembered by members of the Patnude family to have been exceptional for its woodwork and its five fireplaces, one of which was built of local Tenino sandstone. The house is now in very poor condition on the interior. Only one fireplace remains in place. Most of the original architectural fabric has been either covered over or torn out by various owners of the house. Only the front parlor has an intact plaster relief ceiling; the remainder have been lowered. A service porch has been added to the back west side of the house and the main stairway has been boarded up, so that access to the second floor is provided only by means of a back stairway. Although the house is presently occupied, only the ground floor is livable, most of it being in deteriorated condition.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Charles Patnude came to Olympia from Wisconsin in the 1880's. He was a builder by trade, and constructed or helped to construct many of Olympia's major public buildings, including the Old State Capitol, the old St. Peter's Hospital, the Providence Academy, and the 1902 County Courthouse. Patnude manufactured brick in a kiln located where the armory now stands in Olympia. He was a bricklayer, plasterer and mason, as well as the owner of one of the first incorporated businesses in Olympia.

The Patnudes lived in this house for only two years - from 1893 to 1895. At that time it was foreclosed by the Oregon Mortgage Company, as were many Olympia homes, all victims of hard times. Patnude eventually built another home on Jefferson Street in which he lived with his family of fifteen children. The Eighth Avenue house was later purchased by Earl Barton for \$12,850 in 1917. Since that year it has had various owners and was at one time converted into apartments.

The jigsawn ornament of the Patnude House was typical of the era and has remained in remarkably sound condition. The richly-trimmed gables, porches and bays bespeak the optimism of the 1890's in Olympia. Unfortunately, the interior and the foundation have deteriorated to such an extent, it is doubtful the old house can survive without immediate attention.
