PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: This is a two story side hall plan white clapboard house of generally Greek Revival proportions and detail (roof pitch, cornice returns, etc.). Its most prominent architectural feature is a porch with turned posts which extends across the entire south (road) and east (gable or entry) facades. In good condition, the building is enhanced by its siting atop a hill banked with flowering rock gardens.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: This house is a good surviving example of a comfortable dwelling built for one of many local early 20th century immigrant families. Its original German owner worked at both the Cheshire Mills dye house and at Aldworth Manor (IP-15), Arthur Childs' large summer estate. Each of his jobs is representative of a labor need traditionally filled by immigrants during the period. This tradition was carried on by his nephew, Alfred Dietze, who purchased the house in 1935 and was at one time a gardener at the Brewster estate in Dublin. The house has also been owned by a stationmaster at Harrisville. Through its association with the early 20th century themes of immigration, summer resort development and the railroad, it satisfies Criterion A of the National Register of Historic Places.

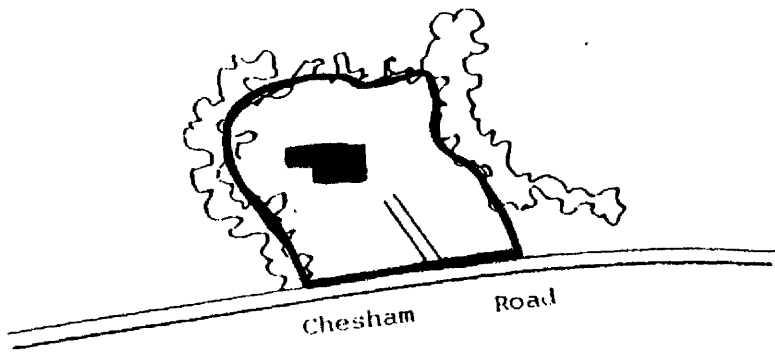
