


Mt. Pleasant Christian Church is a rectangular building with an entrance on the gable end; the front facade is three bay with a single central doorway flanked by sidelights and transom; windows on each side of the door are gothic arched and accented by brick corbelling; side facades are divided into four bays each by brick pilaster; within the gothic arch are double lancet windows; brick corbelling runs along the cornice on the gable end; overhanging eaves are supported by widely space brackets; stone foundation; alterations include the shed roofed porch; modern door; and concrete stucco over brick on rear facade.

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Statement of Significance

The Mt. Pleasant Christian Church is significant under criterion C for 1849 as an example of how Madison County builders used some of the elements of the Gothic Revival style such as the steeply-pitched roof and double-lancet windows to ornament a rural church building.

Verbal Boundary Justification

The boundary was chosen arbitrarily to preserve the building's setback from the road (US 25) and to provide a minimal setting for the building. The boundary is defined by the road (US 25) on the west and a fence on the east. The south boundary excludes a modern water tower.

The boundary includes one contributing building.
