1706 PARISH ESTABLISHED

1715 REV. NATHANIEL OSBORN, MISSIONARY OF THE S.P.G. ARRIVED  
1715 PARISH DEVASTATED BY YEMASSEE INDIANS  
1729 ACT OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY PROVIDED FOR A CHAPEL OF EASE TO  
BE USED AS A IRISH CHURCH UNTIL ONE SHOULD BE BUILT  
1757 JOHN WESLEY PREACHED HERE APRIL 24  
1753 VESTRY ORDERED A BRICK BUILDING TO REPLACE WOODEN CHAPEL  
BUILDING WAS BURNED BETWEEN 1796 and 1806  
HAS SINCE BEEN KNOWN AS THE BURNED CHURCH.  
ERECTED BY NATIONAL SOCIETY OF COLONIAL DAMES - SOUTH CAROLINA, 1944.
