

Constructed by slave labor in 1858, this one-story frame house is elevated on piers. Repeating a distinct T-plan, its square-piered gallery follows the front of the building from one end pavilion to the other. In addition to side lights, the double-door entrance has a rectangular transom. The four windows across the front are floor length, and have wooden shutters.

The front hall is flanked by the parlot on the east and the master bedroom on the west. The original dining room was the big center room back of the hall. A second parlor adjoins it connecting with the front parlor by sliding doors. The east end of the rear extension houses a bedroom. Two additional chambers, the dining room and bedroom, are on the west end. An enclosed staircase ascends from the dining room to the garret lighted by two dormers at the rear, and a second flight leads from here up to the peristyle surmounting the roof. This peristyle or cupola with its square columns and wooden balustrade is in perfect proportion to the main house, echoing its symmetry.


