

Engraved perspective view, north and west facades, c. 1878-1880? The source of this engraving which documents the original appearance of the church is unidentified.


An engraving based on this was published in The West Shore, a magazine of Pacific Northwest literature, art, etc. in February 1880.

Series A #4 of 5 Interior view of auditorium, 1905, showing original configuration of chancel, including bowed pulpit platform and communion rail, and auditorium seating. Note stenciled decoration on walls and ceiling, 25-light gasolier, and the pipe organ. This pipe organ, installed in 1905, replaced the original pipe organ, thought to have been the first in a Methodist church anywhere in the state when the church was dedicated in 1878.


