PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION

The residence at 115 North Grove is a two-and-a-half-story wood frame structure with asymmetrical massing on an irregular plan. The roofs are polygonal. Horizontal siding covers most vertical exterior surfaces. Windows are articulated by structural framing. Eaves are horizontal and pronounced; brackets emphasize their presence. A round turret at the northwest corner highlights the structure. Paired columns support the porch.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Arthur Robinson House is typical of building design in Prescott at the turn of the century. It is "stylish" rather than being modeled after a particular set of European examples and it is less frivolous with ornamentation. Robinson himself was a dealer in confectionery, papers, and periodicals.
