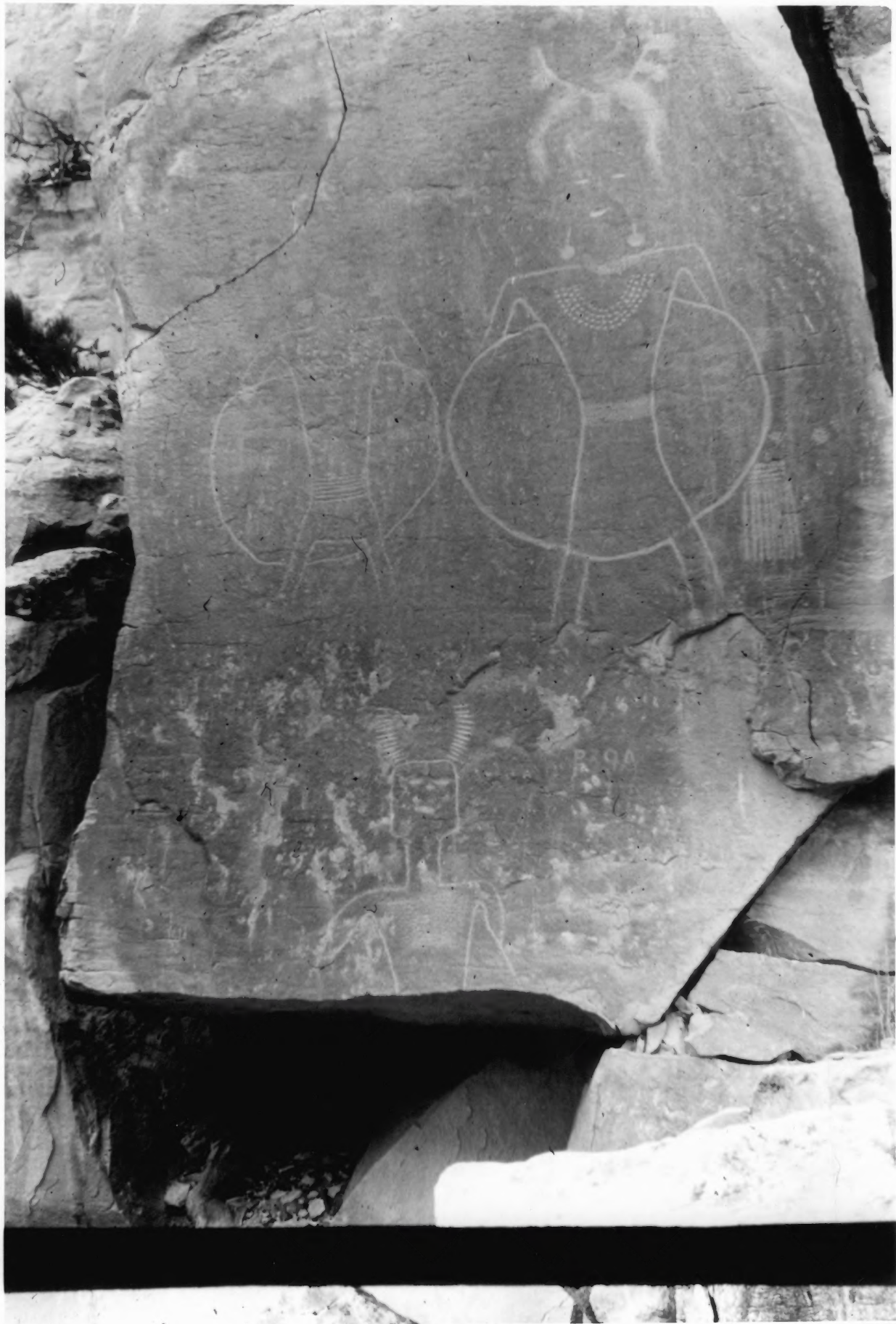

"headdresses" and deeply carved necklaces. Red pigment is
original, white pigment is recent chalking. Note severed
heads or masks. Large figures are 4 to 5 ft. high.

#3 CLOSEUP OF LARGE PETROGLYPH PANEL CONSISTING OF WEATHERED SUPERIMPOSED ANTHROPOMORPHS WITH ELABORATE "HEADDRESSES" AND DEEPLY CARVED NECKLACES. RED PIGMENT IS ORIGINAL, WHITE PIGMENT IS ORIGINAL CHALKING. NOTE SEVERED HEADS OR MASKS. LARGE FIGURES ARE 4 TO 5 FT. HIGH.

AT CENTER RIGHT IS "SKIRT" ALL THAT EVIDENTLY REMAINS OF ANOTHER FIGURE. NOTE
ELABORATE NECKLACES, EARRINGS & HEADDRESSES. SOME CHALKING IS PRESENT.

#6 VIEW OF PANEL CONSISTING OF SEVERAL SUPERIMPOSED ANTHROPOMORPHIC AND ABSTRACT ELEMENTS. MOST ANTHROPOMORPHS ARE "SHIELD" FIGURES WITH BUCKET-SHAPED HEADS; SOME ARE QUITE FADED AND ARE BARELY DISCERNABLE IN THE PHOTO. A LITTLE CHALKING IS PRESENT.
