DESCRIPTION

SUMMARY

The Hendrickson Fish Cabin at Captiva Rocks contributes to the Fish Cabins of Charlotte Harbor Multiple Property Group under Associated Property Type: Fish Cabins of Charlotte Harbor, c. 1920 - 1941. It is an example of the sub-type, Residential Cabins. Located at Captiva Rocks at the south end of Charlotte Harbor, it is a one story, wood frame vernacular building set on wood and concrete pilings over the water. Built before 1930, the building has a corrugated metal gable roof, vertical board siding, and a wood dock.

DESCRIPTIVE STATEMENT

The Hendrickson Fish Cabin at Captiva Rocks was built prior to 1930 by the Punta Gorda Fish Company. (Photo 1) A one story wood frame vernacular building, it is set on wood and concrete pilings over the water at Captiva Rocks shoal in Pine Island Sound, which is at the south end of Charlotte Harbor. The concrete pilings are dated 1929 and 1937. The building has a gable roof made of corrugated metal and is clad in vertical board siding. A wood deck surrounds the building and a wood dock extends from the entry deck to allow for the docking of boats.

The Hendrickson Cabin retains its original form, including decking and pilings. (Photo 2) A variety of historical siding materials is present on the exterior, including shake shingles and lap siding. (Photo 3) The interior layout remains fully intact with beaded tongue and groove walls, flush board siding, and flooring.

SIGNIFICANCE

SUMMARY

The Hendrickson Fish Cabin at Captiva Rocks is significant at the state level under Criterion A for its association with the pre-World War II commercial fishing industry in Charlotte Harbor. The building contributes to the Fish Cabins of Charlotte Harbor Multiple Property Group under Associated Historic Contexts: Commercial Fishing Industry of Charlotte Harbor, c. 1920 - 1941, and Associated Property Type: Fish Cabins of Charlotte Harbor, c. 1920 - 1941. It is an example of the sub-type, Residential Cabins.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

The Hendrickson Cabin at Captiva Rocks is associated with events significant to the history of the Charlotte Harbor commercial fishing industry, one of the largest fishing operations in Florida before World War II. The residential cabin represents a specialized form of architecture designed to meet the specific needs of the Charlotte Harbor fishing industry. Built on pilings above the water, it is made of simple, available materials that could be transported to the site for construction. The cabin is capable of being lifted off its pilings to be moved to more abundant fishing grounds, if necessary. While strictly vernacular in form, it is constructed of the most durable materials available, that of heart pine and cypress, in order to withstand climatic extremes.

The fish camp buildings of Pine Island Sound, where this cabin is located, were constructed in the early 20th century by the Punta Gorda Fish Company. The company built a series of stilt houses throughout Charlotte Harbor and Pine Island Sound. The buildings were used as residences for fishermen, ice houses, and served assorted functions related to the fishing industry such as the mooring of skiffs, drying and cleaning of nets and the storage of fishing equipment. Residential cabins, such as this one, provided a home away from home for fishermen who were on extended fishing expeditions. This form of housing allowed the fishermen to stay in the vicinity of the fishing grounds, rather than travel long distances to their homes on the mainland.
