

Bolton Hall has been changed somewhat from its first appearance, but basically it is the same building as originally, a substantial building of rough field stone secured at the site or from nearby hills. A two-cell jail has been added at the rear in the same rough field stone as the rest of the building, and the bell tower has been finished off with a roof, tiled as is the roof of the rest of the building. On the south side there was once a ramada, but the logs of the ramada have disappeared with time, as have also the vines that covered it, leaving an uncovered porch with cement floor.

Inside, the large auditorium has been made somewhat smaller by partitions creating a room on the southwest corner of the building. The flaor is in bad condition, and much of the plaster of the walls has been broken. Plumbing and electrical wiring have both been removed.

The building is surrounded by a small well-kept park.
