

Description

The Patman House is a one-and-one-half story, gable roof, wood frame vernacular residence with slight Colonial Revival influences. It features a T-shaped plan with a rear ell placed centrally on the rear elevation of the double-pen eastern or front section of the house. A shed projects from the northern side of the ell and a shorter, screened porch extends from the southern side. A single brick interior chimney rises from the intersection of the "T" in the roofline. The house is covered with a corrugated metal roof, sheathed with novelty siding, and supported on brick piers.

The eastern or front elevation is dominated by the central doghouse dormer, with its pair of one-over-one wood sash windows, and by the central shed roof porch below, which shelters the double entry below. Two large one-over-one wood sash windows are placed to either side of the entries.

The gable ends of the northern and southern elevations are virtually identical: a single one-over-one wood sash window is placed centrally on each floor. The shed on the northern elevation is lighted at either end by a single, square fixed pane window and in the center by a one-over-one wood sash window. The screened porch on the southern elevation is accessed by a door placed just to the east of center and entered by a door placed to the east in the ell. A single one-over-one wood sash window is placed to the west of the door and lights the ell behind.

The western elevation is lighted by one one-over-one wood sash window in the center of the gable end of the

This structure was originally a frame dogtrot residence, possibly dating from the late 1890's, but was remodeled by the early 1920's into a double pen plan house when the passageway was enclosed and the rudimentary Colonial Revival details were added (gable returns, box cornices, delicate capitals at the top of the corner trim, beneath the friezeboards). The dormer and new chimney were also added at this time (the earlier chimney projected from the northern slope of the ell, toward the western end). The earlier screen door with Eastlake spindlework seen on the front elevation was probably salvaged from one of the earlier entrances in the passageway. All of the window trim was also added in the 1920's.

Significance

The Patman House survives as the best example in Pangburn of a vernacular, double pen residence with rudimentary Colonial Revival details; it is equally significant for its status as an intact example of the evolution such vernacular structures underwent in railroad towns such as Pangburn, where the sudden influx of prosperity brought on by the railroad both enabled and encouraged the local residents to update and improve their earlier, more rustic homes. It is being nominated under Criterion C with local significance.

Pangburn had been an extremely rural, and as of 1899, an economically depressed town until the construction of the Missouri and North Arkansas rail line in 1906. The routing of this line through Pangburn -- which extended from Harrison to Helena, Arkansas -- provided its residents with both the means to market their agricultural and forest products directly to the outside world and the access to the popular fashions and trends which were sweeping the nation. With this progress came a desire to live in more fashionable, current homes. The Patman House, with its obviously filled dogtrot and the addition of Colonial Revival trim and details, is a remarkably intact example of the manifestation of those changing tastes and their demand for satisfaction.
