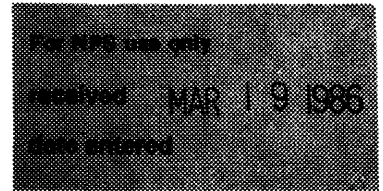

The boundaries of this property are indicated on the attached aerial photograph. This boundary was drawn to include six contributing historic buildings, five of which are related to the historic development of the site. The nominated parcel also includes sufficient property to indicate the historic setting of the hospital.

The nominated parcel is approximately 1.1 acres in size.

One building, site 4-55, is a nineteenth century settler's cabin moved onto the site circa 1960. Although not related to the County Hospital, it is a significant example of the initial residential construction practices of the original Flagstaff settlers.

A rare vestige of Flagstaff's initial settlement, the cabin is related to the current use of the Hospital complex as an interpretive historical museum by the Northern Arizona Pioneers Historical Society, a branch of the Arizona Historical Society.
