L&N STEAM LOCOMOTIVE NO. 151 WAS ONE OF 5 HEAVY
PASSENGER ENGINES (FIRST OF THE 4-6-2 OR "PACIFIC-TYPE"
WHEEL ARRANGEMENT) PURCHASED BY THE LINE IN JANUARY, 1905.
SISTER-ENGINE NO. 152 (PRESERVED BY KY. RAILWAY MUSEUM)
WAS IN THIS GROUP OF NEW ENGINES PUT INTO PASSENGER SERVICE
IN KENTUCKY IN 1905 BY L&N. SO SUCCESSFUL WERE THEY ON
THE ROAD THAT, IN NEXT 3 YEARS (1906-09), L&N CONSTRUCTED
40 SIMILAR ENGINES AT ITS SHOPS IN LOUISVILLE. NOS. 150-154
(INCLUDING NO. 152) WERE BUILT BY ROGERS LOCO. WORKS IN
PATERSON, N. J., HOWEVER, WHERE ORIGINAL PHOTOGRAPH WAS TAKEN.
