#### Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

Situated along the Sioux River in the Dell Rapids City Park, the Gina Smith Campbell bathhouse is a long rectangular building constructed of Sioux quartzite. It measures 32' X 34' with 28' by 24' flanking wings. Originally designed without a roof, the building now has a fiberglass covering so that it can be used as a sheltered picnic area. Decorative stone piers visually separate the different divisions of the building.

Two arched entranceways on the north facade lead to the central core of the building. A flat decorative lintel and bullseye opening (no glass) are located over the entranceways which are flanked by two rectangular openings (no glass). The south facade exhibits a five-part composition with a large double entrance topped with a straight stone lintel and bullseye opening (no glass). Two rectangular openings (no glass) with stone lintels and sills flank this entranceway. Fenestration on the south facade also includes a single arched entranceway on either side of the central bay and a single entranceway and square opening (no glass) on either side of the flanking bays.

No interior features remain today. Originally, interior partitions separated the wings from the central core of the building. Showers and bathrooms were located in the wings.

#### Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

Built in 1934 by the Dell Rapids Park Board and the City Council in cooperation with the Civil Works Administration, the Gina Smith Campbell bathhouse is significant in the area of recreation.

The bathhouse was designed by P.L. Peterson. A plaque dedicates the building to Gina Smith Campbell "whose vision and industry led to the establishment of the Dell Rapids Bathing Beach in 1917".<sup>1</sup> Mrs. U.S. Earls writes about the beach and bathhouse in <u>The History of Dell Rapids</u>:

"Credit must be given to several men for starting and making the city park but to Gina Smith Campbell credit must be given for a bathing beach which was outstanding in this area at that time. Literally hundreds of town people were attracted here for swimming and thousands to enjoy our very clean and beautiful park. Later when the stone bathhouse was finished, Gina was sent an airplane ticket to Dell Rapids..."2

The bathhouse, like many other buildings in Dell Rapids, was constructed of native Sioux quartzite. Although it no longer is used as a bathhouse, its picturesque setting along the Sioux River makes it a favorite picnic area in the city park. The building today is a visual reminder of the once popular bathhouse.
