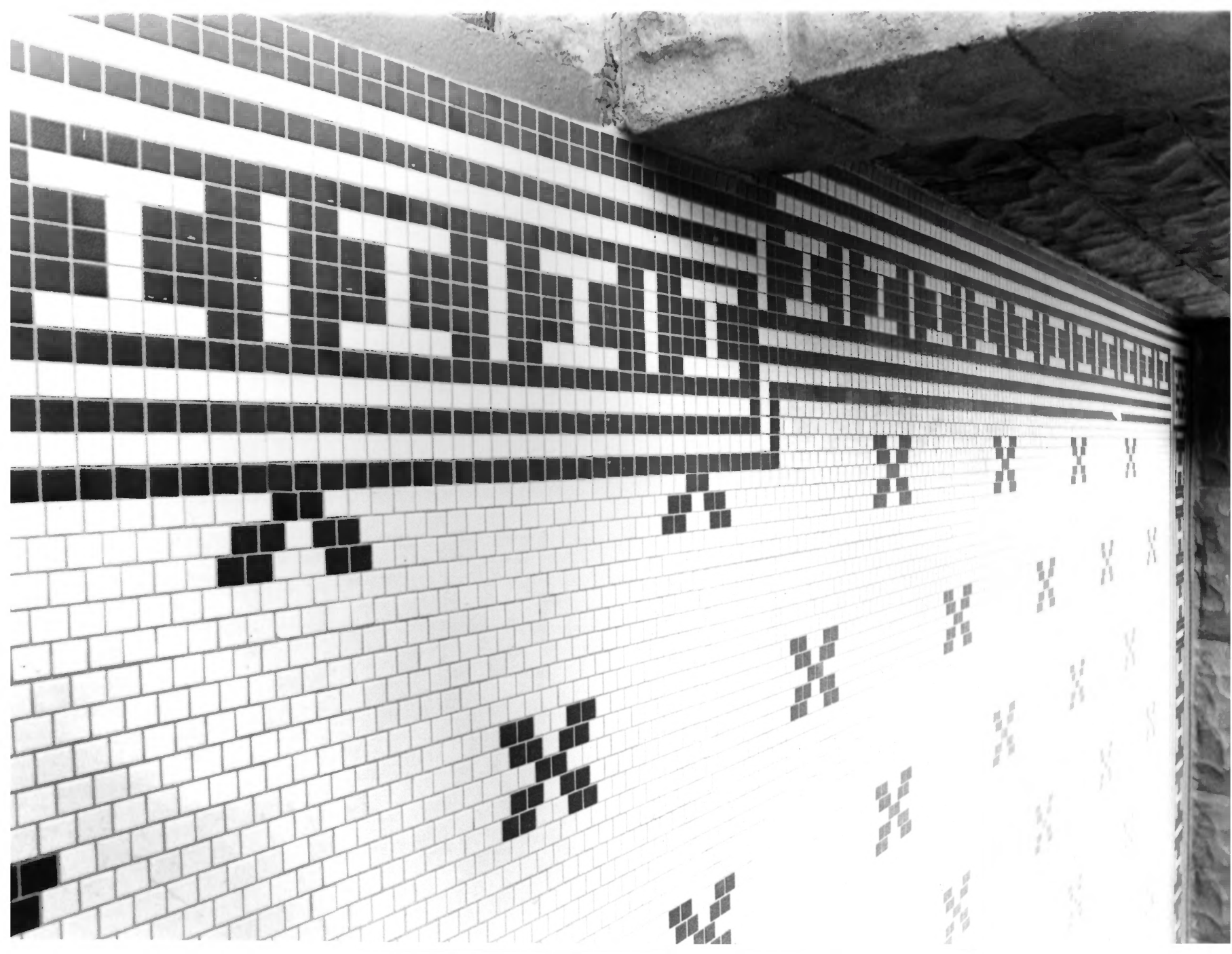

ROESCH MOVERS PROVIDED SOME STEEL BEAMS FOR SLAB SUPPORT BUT WARNED OF APPARENT SIGNS OF FAILURE. WE CONSIDERED REPAIRING EXISTING TILE, PROVIDING A REINFORCED CONCRETE SLAB BELOW THE ORIGINAL BY A PRESSURE GROUTING PLACEMENT (REQUIRING A SLAB DESIGN AND COST FIGURES PLUS NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE TILE SUPPLIERS.) OUR ALTERNATIVE WAS TO HAVE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM OLEAN'S IN NEW YORK TO RECORD THE TILE PATTERN FOR DUPLICATION BY THE USE OF PHOTOGRAPHS AND DRAWINGS TO SCALE THAT WERE PROVIDED. WE CHOSE THE LATER BECAUSE THE COST OF THE FORMER WAS EXORBITANT. THE COLORS ARE IDENTICAL.

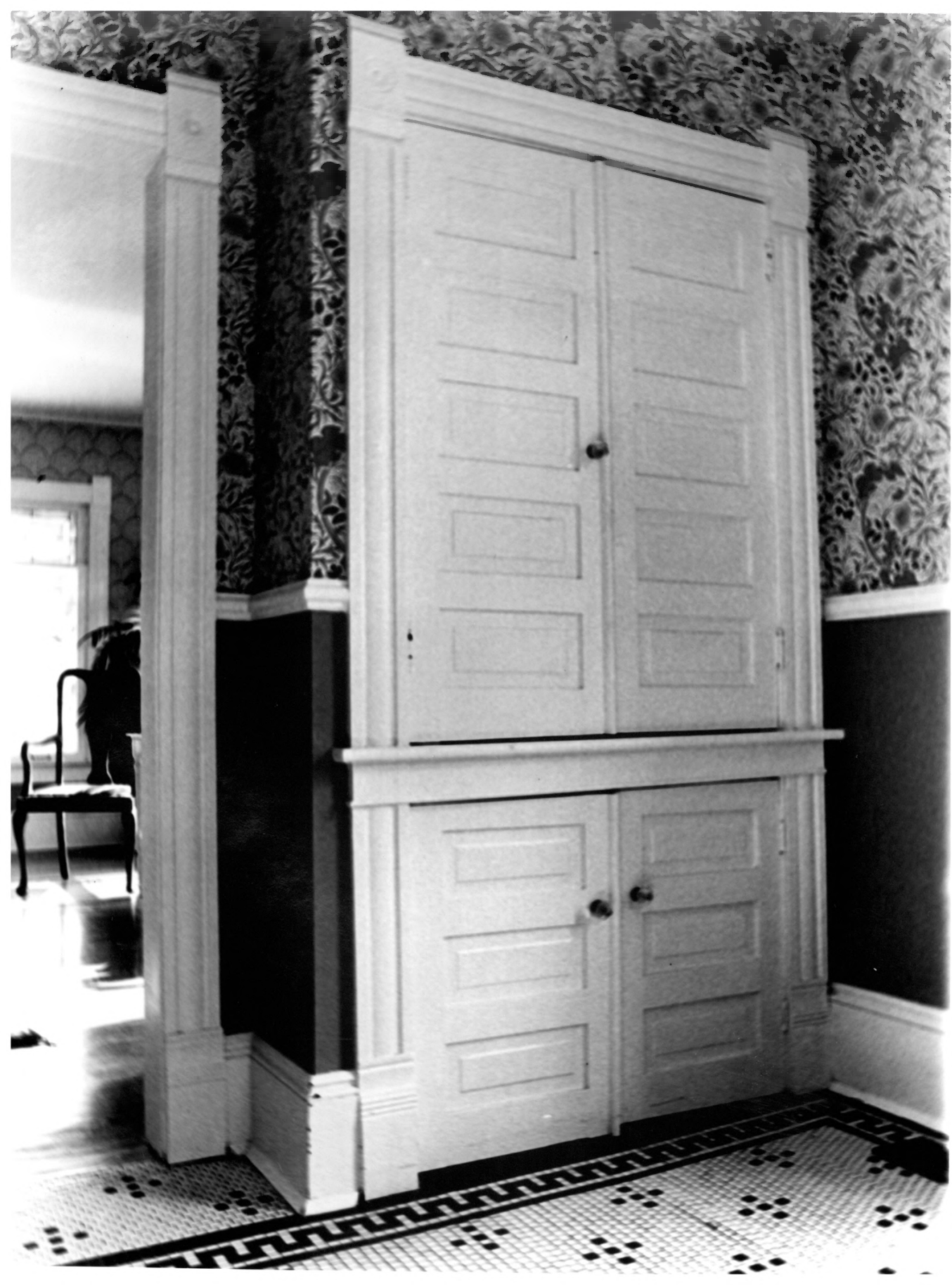
