DISCUSSION AS REQUIRED: This home was once part of the community of Layton, founded by a Mormon settlement in the 1800's. This home is representational of a Queen Anne style residence of the L-plan. Built in 1895, it reflects the impact of the railroad, which upon opening, brought imported mass produced detailing to Safford. These detail elements include jigsaw trimmed pediment, narrow paired front windows with transoms and turned wood porch supports. This home is the earliest home displaying these details. The porch has been altered from its original 1-plan, which matched the original design of the home. Original materials were used to re-construct the porch, however, and though the design has been altered, the
