PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: A traditional center chimney, five bay center entry white clapboard cape cottage, this house can readily be compared to other approximately contemporary upland hill farm houses nearby (TP-3) and in western Harrisville (cf. PD-23 and IP-24). Oriented to take advantage of a southern exposure, it has two pairs of 9/6 windows on its principal façade plus an enclosed entrance porch which obscures the door and sidelighted surround. Additions include two chimneys (one a replacement for the original center one) and an eastern ell (a 1970s porch conversion). There is a modern free standing two car garage/barn to the west. The property is in fair condition

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: This is a good example of an upland New Hampshire farmstead typical of those carved out of the wooded hillsides of the region in the growth period after the Revolution. Built by Asa Fiske, newly arrived from Holden, MA, it was farmed and occupied by members of the Fiske family for 85 years. The property of several short term owners thereafter, it was bought by carpenter Eugene Gilchrest in 1915 and remains in his family.

Further, the house retains enough original fabric and qualities of its setting (arrangement of buildings around dooryard, stone walls, old maple trees, etc.) to qualify it under Criterion C as well as Criterion A of the National Register of Historic Places.




