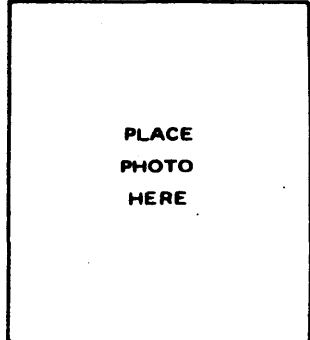

Research to date has reached only to Otis Winn in 1865. Owners say they were told it was built by a Capt Winn, who was a sea captain.*

Architectually

Has three fireplaces downstairs and one on central chimney. Left front room has the bake oven. Back center room has the full window shutters

Wainscoting remains in the main house.

Front stairway goes to the right - the hand carved banister reportedly carved by the sea captain.
