

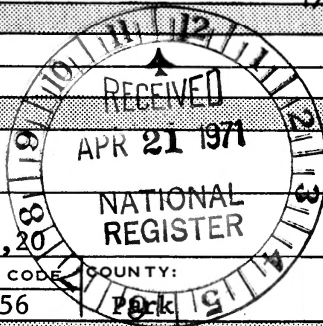

DESCRIBE VIEW, DIRECTION, ETC. Viewed from the east, and from the south side (Cedar Mountain side) of Shoshone Canyon, and from about 300 yards down stream from Buffalo Bill Dam, Mt. to the left is Cedar Mt.; to the right is Rattlesnake Mt.; in center middle background is Sheep Mt.; in distant background (approx. 15 miles) is snow covered Wapiti Ridge, 12,000 plus foot peak of the Absaroka Range.
