Description

Two-story, brick (common bond) building with stepped parapet on facade. Most windows have twelve-paned metal sash, which are hinged; windows on the first story of the facade have six-over-six wood sash.

Significance

The A.H. Buchan Company Building is believed to have been constructed between 1924 and 1930 for the W.A. Gray Tobacco Company. It was used as a redrying plant. In 1933 the building was purchased by the A.H. Buchan Tobacco Company. The A.H. Buchan Company had been found in 1920 for the purpose of buying, drying, and exporting tobacco; it operated in this building until 1964. The A.H. Buchan Company Building is important for its role in the processing of tobacco in Mullins.
