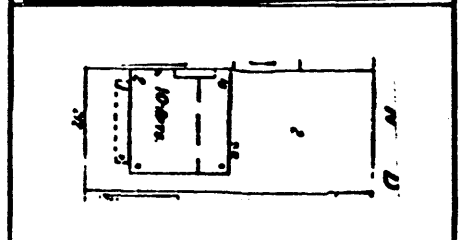

DESCRIPTION

FORM 2 stories, square plan, hipped roof, projecting frontispiece CONST. DATE c. 1865
MATERIALS Brick (painted), stone ARCH STYLE Italianate
FENESTRATION Shallow segmental arches w/brick hoods; round arch at center front
DIST. FEATURES Frontispiece (see below)
ALTERATIONS Porch dates from early 20th century
SITE & RELATED STR. Raised lot, high stone retaining wall

STATEMENT

This house is a distinctive local example of the Italianate style. Of particular interest is the projecting frontispiece, with round-arched doorway and similarly-arched window above that is framed by pairs of short columns on high pedestals. Above this window is an arched corbel table. The whole is capped with a roof that repeats the arch motif. Smooth wall surfaces and restrained detail are characteristic of this style in Davenport at mid-century.
