DESCRIPTION The 1906 Gustad House is a $\frac{1}{2}$ story gable structure. The front facade presents a symmetrical appearance with an open porch, echoing the horizontal expanse of the house itself. The porch features a center shingled gable dormer supported by turned columns and spindled upper rails. Decorative shingles in the Queen Anne tradition, fill the large frontend gables and porch pediment. The south facade has a one story bay with a stained glass upper pane, and an enclosed porch. Gable ends are faced with decorative shingles, while the rest of the structure is faced with clapboard siding. The farmstead also has a gable horse barn, a gambrel dairy barn, a summer kitchen with a jerkin head roof, a granary, and a chicken house.

SIGNIFICANCE

The 1906 Gustad House is significant architecturally because it represents part of the development of Victorian influence typical to the resource area. The house illustrates the late interaction of Queen Anne "Victorian Cottage" decorative traditions in a small-scale, symmetrical design.
