NATIONAL REGISTER CRITERIA STATEMENT (if applicable)

The Captain Alexander Crocker House possesses integrity of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling and association. It is significant as the home of a prominent local sea captain and as a fine unaltered example of the Italianate style with period barn. It thus meets criteria B and C of the National Register of Historic Places.

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.

The Crocker House is one of the finest unaltered examples of the Italianate style in Hyannis, even retaining its attached barn. The Italianate style is well represented in Hyannis. Facing its three-bay gable end to the street, the house boasts such distinguishing features as a bracketed cornice, paneled corner boards, a heavy bracketed entry hood and flanking bracketed bay window, a round arched gable window, and thinly projecting lintels over other windows which contain 2/2 sash. The attached barn has a cupola rising from the center of the gable roof.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.

Captain Alexander Crocker (1843-1890) was the son of Deacon Timothy Crocker and brother to Captain William Crocker. He was master of both deep water and coasting vessels including the schooners New York, Bay State, and Western Starr, the barques Sara Hobert and Alice and the yacht Rambler.
