PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: <i>The Cote House is a one-and-a-half-story school house of three-inch vertical plank sheathed in clapboards. It measures approximately 24' x 22' and is two bays across by three bays deep. The structure stands on a fieldstone and granite foundation and has a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. The off-center entry includes a four-light transom. The northwest is a shed-roofed outhouse with vertical plank siding.</i>		
STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: <i>This structure was built c. 1846 and was the Goshen Center Schoolhouse. It is constructed of three-inch vertical plank and is known to have been built by John Chandler, noted local builder noted for his use of plank construction. Closed as a school in 1926, the structure is now used as a dwelling. It is one of three surviving school buildings in the town from an earlier total of five.</i>

Boundaries of the nominated property are highlighted in yellow on the attached sketch map. These boundaries represent those which were historically associated with the Center Schoolhouse.


