19: History (cont.):

Although no direct linkage to John Sandidge has been established at present, it is known that Dabney Sandidge acquired the property in 1865 from W. W. Thompson. Dabney sold to P. W. Sandidge in 1881. P. W.'s heirs sold the land to Harry and Johnny Higgason with the present owner acquiring full title in 1979.

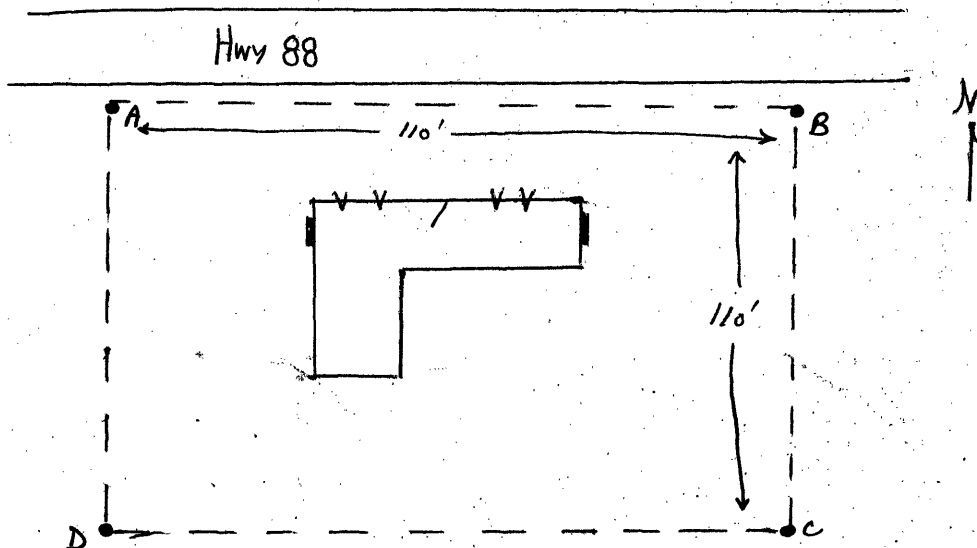

BOUNDARY HAS NO SIGNIFICANT OUTBUILDINGS.

Beginning at point A 30' from the NW corner of the house, thence E along a picket fence 110' to point B; thence S along a fence 110' to point C; thence W 110' along a fence to point D; thence N along a fence to the beginning.
