DESCRIPTION

6. Briefly describe the present physical appearance of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

The LaGrange Adobe Post Office is a pre-1850 rectangular building with a slate foundation. The individual adobe bricks measure approximately 16-18" by 3-4". Rear door and side windows appear to be set in at a later date.

To prevent further

deterioration large wooden boards, approximately 2'by 8', have been bolted into the adobe fabric on the side and rear walls. Later alterations include 2' wide redwood siding on the facade, a wood shed continguous to one side of the structure and a protective tin roof. Apparently the wood additions date to the building's use as a barn.

Constructed of adobe it is a representative example of a distinctive architectural technology ticed by the Spanish pre-1850 and by some of the first Californians. Th slightly raised slate foundation is also typical of building practices o period. Evidently the rectangular adobe structure was used by LaGrange post office during the community's early history. It may have been built this civic function in mind during the early 1850's or, more likely, it adapted for this use during the gold rush years.
