However, the land was originally a part of a 500 acre survey of Robert Irvin purchased by John Emerson. Emerson sold to Thomas Vaughn in 1802. Vaughn owned until 1865 at which time he sold to John A. Brownlee. John's son, Henry acquired it and his heirs sold to Arthur Gaines in 1903. The Gaines family owned it until they sold to the present owners in 1961.

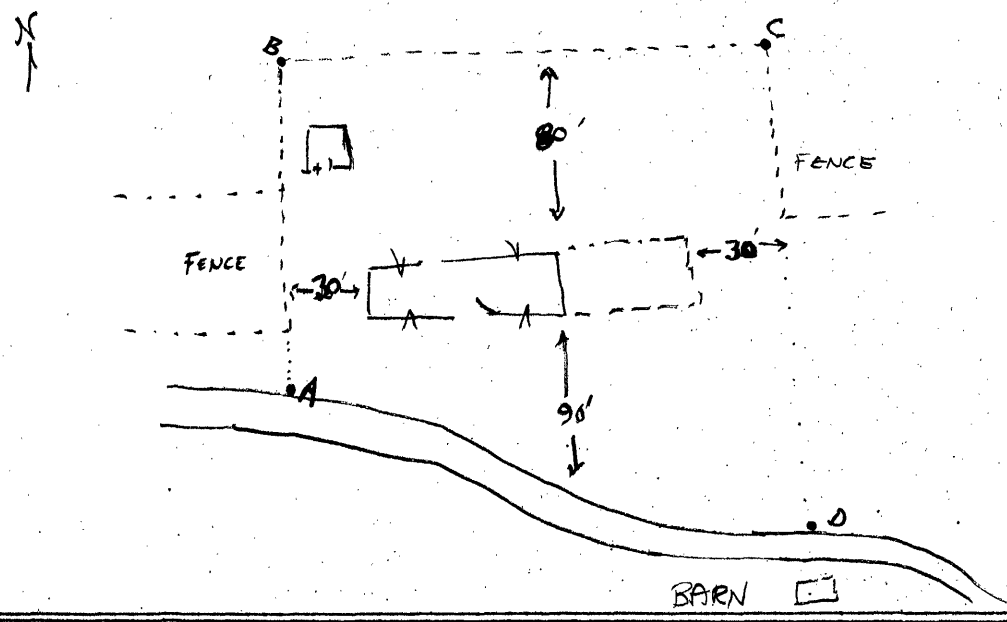

Verbal Boundary Description Acres .8 ACRES

Bounded on N, W, E by fence line. E and W fence lines are to extend as imaginary lines to road which is the S boundary.

Beginning at point A, 60' from the SW corner of the house and in a direct line with a fence running north, along the fence line 170' to point B, thence E along a fence line 150' to point C; thence S along a fence line as extended to the N side of a road at point D 190'; thence along the meanders of the road to the beginning.
