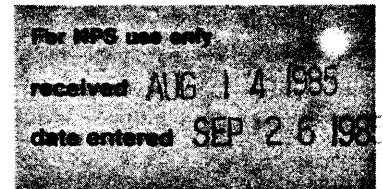

4. Owner: Felipe Peña, 1112 Mora, Las Vegas (same as #'s 1607, 1639).
7. Description: T-shape plan; rubble sandstone foundation; common bond brick walls with sandstone quoins, stucco over adobe (rear); wood shingle roof; small enclosed eaves with some "modillion" brackets; imbricated wood shingles in gable; 1/1 double-hung windows with sandstone sills and segmental arches; two single doors with transoms on porch; lathe-turned porch columns, high "bases," molding string "capitals," cut-out brackets; spindle frieze. Located in a residential block facing a shaded park/playing field and buildings of Highlands University.
8. Significance: A finely detailed, and because it was built between 1908 and 1913, a late Queen Anne Style house. The asymmetry, mixture of brick, sandstone and wood shingles, and the porch details place it in this stylistic category. The porch elaboration includes lathe-turned columns with high "bases," a molding course supporting cut-out brackets and a spindle frieze. The hipped gable skirt with modillion brackets hints at the then ten-year-old presence of classical revivalism.
