SIGNIFICANCE: The best example of an Italian Baroque Villa in Georgia. The mansion is based on elements of 3 Italian Villas, the Villas Cuzzano (near Verona), Gori (in Sienna), and Spada (in Rome). The siting of the house and comprehensive landscape design now much altered are testament to the talent of Philip Shutze and the firm of Hentz, Reid, and Adler.

The handling of the interior spaces and detail is superb, in short a superlative design. Andrew Calhoun, the original owner, born in 1882, was a son of Dr. Abner W. Calhoun, noted eye doctor. The homes of his brother and sister, F. P. Calhoun and Mrs. Stuart Witham, in the West Andrews District, are modest compared to this one.

Calhoun was in real estate. He married in 1907, Mary Guy Trigg of Chattanooga, Tennessee. The name for this house is a Welsh interpretation using her name. The house was called "one of the show places of Georgia", shortly after its completion.
