VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A at the NE corner of the yard outside the driveway and edge of lawn at the fence, thence S perpendicular to fence 270 ft to B, thence W parallel to fence 300 ft to C, thence N along bottom of the bank below the spring house to the fence at D, thence E with fence to the beginning containing the house, quarters, and spring house and an area of about 1/2 acre. The barns are later period.
