ATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

The Dials are an important Meridian family among the early settl and J. R. Dial, original owner of the house, operated the first gin and saw mill after the Civil War. In 1872 J. R. Dial sold f acres for a fairground to the East Mississippi Agricultural and Mechanical Association, at that time the only agricultural socie this part of the state. This fairgrounds became the site of the Meridian Fair and Exposition Association in 1890, which later (1 deeded the land to the City, for creation of a park (Highland Pa entered on the National Register of Historic Places in 1979).

E. H. Dial was mayor of Meridian from 1893 until 1901. It was d his term that the city installed a sewerage system and began the street paving. Dial was also a federal court clerk attorney. T present owner of the house, Kate Dial Sanford, is the daughter o Dial.
