## RESUBMISSION WILLCOX MRA

Johnson-Tillotson House (124 N. Curtis)  
Cochise County  
ARIZONA

This nomination was returned for substantive reasons. Originally, the Johnson-Tillotson House was nominated under criteria "B" (Ranching) and "C" (Architecture). However, the Register's reviewer felt that "C" was justified but that criterion "B" was not. The reviewer stated that context was lacking for "B" since the nomination did not identify how this property was associated with a specific Johnson. The reviewer stated that in order to nominate this property for both criteria, an expanded discussion on Johnson's contribution to local ranching in Willcox would need to be developed. However, the reviewer also stated that "B" may be removed from the consideration by amending the area of significance to state only "Architecture".

The Arizona SHPO office is unable to develop an expanded discussion on Johnson's contribution to local ranching in Willcox. The nomination has been amended by deleting "B" from the form so that this property now is only nominated under criterion "C".
