State significance of property, and justify criteria, criteria considerations, and areas and periods of significance noted above:

Significance

Constructed in 1945, the Sylamore Creek Bridge is associated with the World War II Era historic context and is of the wire-cable suspension type. The Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department in 1942 as job #5243 developed plans and specifications for the Sylamore Creek Bridge. Mr. N. B. Garver was the principal engineer for bridge design at the time and \$15,000 was allocated for construction which would be done in-house by AHTD The Arkansas Foundry Company in Little Rock did the steel fabrication for the towers, anchorage and floor assemblies. When completed in 1945, the Sylamore Creek Bridge stretched 202 feet in length and was 19 feet 6 inches in width with an 11-foot clear roadway.

The Sylamore Creek Bridge is one of two surviving wire-cable suspension bridges documented in Arkansas. The other surviving bridge is the Beaver Bridge in Carroll County. A third wire-cable suspension bridge, the Winkley Bridge, was destroyed in the early 1990s. Given its excellent and intact condition, the Sylamore Creek Bridge maintains the integrity of its historic period and is thus locally eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C.

Verbal Boundary Description: Beginning at a point approximately 5 feet southeast of the southeast edge of County Road 283 proceed northwest parallel to the bridge approximately 320 feet to a point at the end of the eastern-most of the two northwest anchorages, thence southwest approximately 30 feet to a point at the end of the western-most of the two northwest anchorages, thence southeast parallel to the bridge approximately 320 to a point at the end of the western-most of the southeast anchorages, thence northeast approximately 30 feet to the point of origin.

Boundary Justification: This boundary includes all the property historically associated with this resource.





NORTH EAST ELEVATION, LOOKING SOUTHWEST








