
The plan of the Day house is irregular with projecting bays and porches and a two-story wing to the west.

The exterior has a variety of complex and interrelated contrasts of shape and color. These eclectic and ornate elements are integrated into a pleasing aesthetic unity: (1) The limestone of the exterior walls is organized in patterns by string courses of brownstone and below the eves by a chequered pattern of blue and pink limestone. (2) The dormers in the roof and the over-hanging gables are covered by scalloped shingles which are deep red (Originally the shingles of the roof were also this color). (3) The columns, railings, scrolled braquets, pierced work, consoles, and moldings about window frames and dormers are painted a deep brown similar to the color of the brownstone.

(4) The single half-timbered gable has the pattern of the tree of life. On the front porch gable is a carved design of birds and leaves painted in gold and blue which is the same color as the blue limestone under the eaves.

The exterior has recently been sandblasted and efforts have been made to restore the building to its 1884 form. Only the shingles of the roof —now a pink red—fail to duplicate what is known of the original color. These were a deep red. This change notable affects the appearance of the house. If it were the same color as the scalloped shingles the building would appear to be both more coherent and more top-heavy.

The interior is typical of the period. Fireplaces on the ground floor have elaborately carved mantels. The fireplace openings are framed with tiles which have colorful patterns. Some rooms have plaster cornices with complicated patterns in los relief.
