IV. cont.: In terms of agriculture, this property is significant as an example of the smaller farm (as opposed to the larger plantation) common to the multiple-resource area and this part of the state.

In terms of exploration and settlement, the property is significant for representing the kind of agricultural development characteristic of the early white settlement in the multiple-resource area.
