

Physical Description

This two-story bank building occupies a corner site in the downtown commercial district of Conway, presenting a formal, classical-influenced facade to the streetscape. The simple rectangular massing is capped by a flat roof and faced with tan brick; it is set on a low dressed stone foundation. The facade is organized by four monumental stone Tuscan engaged columns set on high plinths supporting an unembellished entablature. The name of the building "Farmers State Bank" and two laurel wreaths are carved on the stone parapet that crowns the simple cornice. The double leaf doorway features a surround of stylized egg and dart molding and is capped by a stone panel enriched with an eagle and laurel wreath motif carving. Crowning this appear a series of classical moldings terminated by a simple cornice capped with a parapet. A range of brick pilasters with simple capitals capped by a simple stone molding organizes the side elevation. The plate glass and glass brick infill are replacements for banks of multi-paned windows.

Statement of Significance

The Farmers State Bank Building in Conway, Arkansas, was designed by the Thompson and Harding firm in 1918. This two-story building rests on a corner lot at a major intersection in downtown Conway and presents an image of stability and dignity to the streetscape. With its imposing facade featuring four monumental Tuscan engaged columns, this structure is the most formal and imposing of the firm's several Neo-Classical designs for small-town banks.


