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**Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance**

The Hedlund Motor Company Building is a one and two story structure, patterned after the Mission Revival style, and constructed in 1918. North-south dimensions are 47 feet in width, east-west measurements are 142 feet in length, and it occupies the southeast corner of business district intersection. The west facade of the building contains two 10'X10' glass show windows whose transoms have been closed with stucco and capped with decorative brows. Above each window is a curvilinear niche, protected from above by a bracketed projection covered with red clay tiles. The north facade, consisting of a similar show window and a minor entrance is similarly treated. A Pseudo Indian design, consisting of tiles applied to the stucco walls, describes a horizontal line just below the second floor brackets. This line is crossed with vertical accents occurring at the corner, sides and either side of the center line of the facades. The curvilinear parapet of the second story tops the structure with emphasis at the corners and centers of the facades.

A long one-story element of the north facade of the building, stretches east, displaying metal windows (9 in number) with hopper vents. The tile decoration is picked up with square spots between the top of each mullion and the coping of the parapet above.

The 1950 addition to the building is to the south and east of the structure and does not affect the historic integrity of the structure.

**Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)**

The Hedlund Motor Company Building is significant for its Mission Revival style architecture and for its role in the commercial history of Elk City, Oklahoma.

Constructed in 1918, the Hedlund Motor Company building was designed in the Mission Revival style. It is the only example of this architectural influence applied to a commercial structure in Elk City.

Historically, the structure is also significant. Hedlund Motor Company was established in 1913 and is the second oldest Ford dealership in the state. The company had the nominated building constructed for its headquarters in 1918 as the original structure had become too small for the expanding business. It has continued to serve in a commercial use since that time.
