### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Trulock-Gould-Mullis House is a one-and-one-half-story frame structure with touches of classicism in its architectural style. Although containing classical elements, through the use of narrow arched windows and pointed gables the total effect of the house is that of a Gothic cottage. The house is sheathed in clapboard siding with corner boards. A steep pointed gabled roof with diamond-shaped shingles covers the house.

The facade (north elevation) is symmetrical with a one-story, flat-roofed portico spanning the width of the structure. This portico is supported by six Doric-capital columns. The entry features a large round-arched single door with a semi-circular transom. The door is flanked by narrow sidelights. The entry is flanked on either side by two floor-level windows. These windows are double-hung, single-light sash with Adam style trim.

The second floor level of the facade is marked by a steep gable. Located in the center of this gable end is a grouping of three arched windows which, although unusually vertical, present a Palladian effect. This group of windows is flanked on either side by a narrow double-hung, single-sash window.

One of the most outstanding features of the Trulock-Gould-Mullis House is the row of ornate bargeboard along the cornice. Another distinctive feature of the house is the use of a bay window on both the east and west elevation. These bay windows are polygon shaped and feature five, single-sash, double-hung windows. Fenestration on the bay windows is simple in design. These windows are topped by a seamless metal roof. Windows on the east and west elevations vary in design and size ranging from a small single-sash, double-hung window to double-hung, six-over-six-light windows.

The Trulock-Gould-Mullis House rests in excellent condition on its original site in an historic area of Pine Bluff, Arkansas.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Trulock-Gould Mullis House was completed in May or June, 1876. The Pine Bluff Press said on April 27, 1876, "Marshall Trulock's new residence on West Barraque will soon be completed." In those days Trulock's home was a splendid addition to the city which was just recovering from the Reconstruction period. The outward appearance of the home was not changed to any marked degree since its completion. The style of architecture is simple, very much like its builder, who was described as a plain, affable man.

Marshall Sutton Trulock was the fourth surviving child of James Hines and Amanda Beardsley Trulock, who came to Jefferson County from Georgis in 1844. He was born at the family plantation near Atkins Lake on March 27, 1848. Trulock married Julia I. Hammett on November 13, 1873. Julia was the daughter of John J. Hammett and was born in Pine Bluff on January 5, 1854. Their only son, Harry E. Trulock, was born in the house on November 8, 1876. In addition to Harry, the Trulocks had three daughters, Lucy G., born October 22, 1874 - died August 8, 1892; Jessie, born September 3, 1878 - died April 5, 1881; and Ouita, born December 11, 1880 - died February 9, 1888.

Trulock sold the house to James Gould on September 30, 1905. Gould, the son of Josiah and Frances Barnett Gould, was born in Bradley County on April 13, 1854. He came to Pine Bluff in the 1870's to work in a mercantile establishment. He married Belle Holland, the daughter of W. H. Holland, in 1878. She died in 1896 and Gould married Beulah Benton on December 2, 1897.

Gould's first venture in politics was to run for City Treasurer in 1883. He defeated an older citizen, R. H. M. Mills on April 3, 1883, by a vote of 396 to 375. In 1902 he was elected Sheriff of Jefferson County and served two terms, 1902-1906. He ran for County Judge in 1906 and received a majority vote. He was re-elected in 1908. He withdrew from politics after completing his second as County Judge and entered business. He was one of the early bond brokers in Arkansas. After County Judge R. H. Williams died in office in 1936, Gould was appointed to complete his term on April 22, 1936. He died from a sudden heart attack on June 8, 1937.

After renting the house for a number of years, the Gould heirs sold the residence to Ben Pearson on July 6, 1966. Pearson restored the house and it has been the home of Mr. and Mrs. Bart Mullis since.

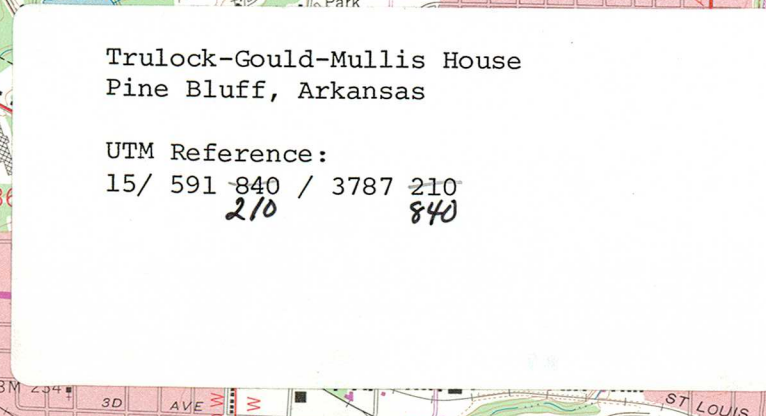

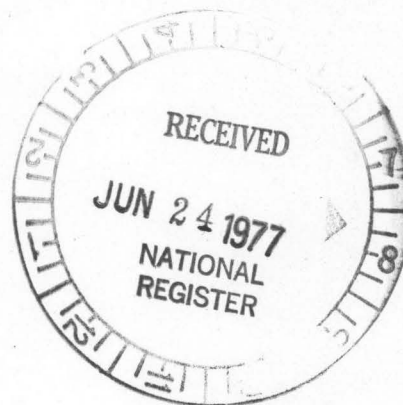
