On the exterior, the large planks pegged together diagonally to form the trusses (and side walls) of the bridge are sheathed with flush boards hung vertically. Similar siding protects the ends of the trusses immediately inside the portals. There are rectangular openings in the siding near the southeast and northwest corners of the bridge to provide better visibility for on-coming traffic. The gable ends of the bridge differ, owing to recent repair work. The east end has vertical flush boards painted white, with a roof overhang of about 2 feet; the west end -- which has been rebuilt -- is flat with unpainted vertical flush boards. The roof of the bridge is covered with corrugated metal sheeting.
