adjacent southeast lot, which is believed to be the foundation of the doctor's office and which is known to have been located near his home. However, it is also the case that in the revolutionary period the road ran by what is now the rear of the house, and it is improbable that the leanto would have faced the road. This is the most obvious puzzle with regard to the history of the house.

This house has significance also in its association with Dr. Turner who

was the Surgeon General of the Continental Army during the Revolutionary War, assistant surgeon of the Army at Ticonderoga and First Surgeon of the Connecticut Troops at Boston.

In 1777 Congress appointed him Director-General of the General Hospital and later made him Surgeon-General of the Eastern Department, where he remained until nearly the end of the War. He moved to New York in 1800, continued his practice and was appointed Surgeon to the Staff of the United States Army.
