VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A at the SE corner of the yard where the rock fence meets the farm fence & running with the fence around the yard 400 ft N to B, 125 ft E to C, 490 ft S to D making rock fence at road & with rock fence 190 ft W to the beginning, including the house, well & dairy.
