## DESCRIPTION

Wescott (Westcoat) Road, located on Edisto Island to the west of S. C. Highway 174, and running southeast from a point 1/2 mile south of the intersection of S. C. Highway 174 and Oak Island Road to near Bailey's Store (see individual inventory form), is an oak-lined dirt road approximately 2/5 mile in distance. The road both begins and ends at its intersection with S. C. Highway 174. At least two other dirt roads (driveways) intersect with this road.

## SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANCE

One of the last undisturbed remnants of the main road on Edisto Island, Wescott (or Westcoat) Road, undoubtedly named for the Westcoat (sometimes spelled Wescoat) family of a nearby plantation, is according to local tradition a short stretch of what was the old King's Highway. Laid down in the Colonial era, this section of the road was isolated when S. C. Highway was straightened and paved ca. 1940.(1)

Mill's Atlas indicates a main road through Edisto Island along the approximate route of the present-day thoroughfare. Preserved for its beauty, this section of the road is maintained by Charleston County.(2)

ACREAGE: Approximately 1.9 acres

VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION: The nominated property is shown as the black line on the accompanying Charleston County Tax Map #71-0-0, with an approximate scale of 1 inch equalling 400 feet. It includes the historic road (Wescott) Road and its right-of-way.
