This photo is a view looking north with the Large Powder Magazine in the background. The dimensions are 338' x 35'. The quarters were three stories high and housed 1,000 men. Fire destroyed the quarters in 1912.



The cistern is the only substantial water storage area in the Fort. It is composed of three chambers, with a total capacity of about 94,000 gallons. Its roof serves as a water catchment area.
