#### SUMMARY OF PRESENT AND ORIGINAL PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

3500 Via De La Reina is an irregular, two-story Spanish styled building constructed of stucco over hollow tile. The central block of the building has a barrel tiled hip roof. A one-story wing on the east has a flat roof with a clay barrel tile parapet. A two-bay garage with a gable roof is attached to the north side of this wing. North of the central block of the building is a two-story wing with four six-lite casement windows on each of its three sides. The wing is covered by a barrel tiled hip roof with exposed rafter ends. A string course is located beneath the windows. North of this wing is a one-story wing with a tile gable roof and moulded cornice with canalles grouped in the gable end.

#### TEXT SUPPORTING SUMMARY OF PRESENT AND ORIGINAL PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

South of the central block of the building is a one-and-one-half-story wing with a tiled gable roof with groups of canalles in the gable ends and at intervals under the cornice. At each end of the wing is a tiledone-story porch. The porch has french doors with side lites set in a segmental arched frame. Fenestration is generally four-lite casement with stone sills or french doors. A terrace with a broken tile floor extends the length of the main facade from the porch to the main entrance door. The door has a shouldered architrave decorated with urns and vinette outlined in an egg and dart molding. Two balconettes with wrought iron railings are also located on the main facade. #### SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

3500 Via De La Reiva is significant as one of 25 remaining structures built as part of the San Jose Estates development, a planned, self-contained suburban community developed in 1925 by a group of Jacksonville businessmen at the height of the Florida Land Boom. As do the majority of the original San Jose structures, the building reflects the Spanish or Mediterranean Revival style of architecture developed for the subdivision by the Jacksonville architects Marsh and Saxelbye. The building possesses sufficient architectural integrity and historical significance through association with the San Jose development to be individually eligible for nomination as part of the accompanying thematic nomincation.

#### TEXT SUPPORTING SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

3500 Via De La Reina was built by O. P. Woodcock with the mortgage held by San Jose Estates. The original selling price of this lot was \$4,900.00. Beginning in 1927 a number of liens and mortgage transfers were initiated, including the following principals: O. P. Woodcock, San Jose Estates, the Florida National Bank, Policheck Brothers, Lancaster Comapny and the Ormond Beach Bond Company. When title was finally cleared in a suit brought by the Christopher Point Company in 1935, the house was sold to Parker Sheldon and then to C. R. George. That same year it was sold to Almours Securities, Inc., an Alfred I. DuPont company. Title was then transferred to the estate of Alfred I. DuPont, then back to Almours Securities Inc., and finally to the St. Joe Paper Company, another Alfred I. DuPont Company. In 1946, the St. Joe Paper Company sold the house to Joseph Holness, Jr. In 1948 it was sold to the present owners. This house has been meticulously maintained and is virtually unaltered from its original appearance.
