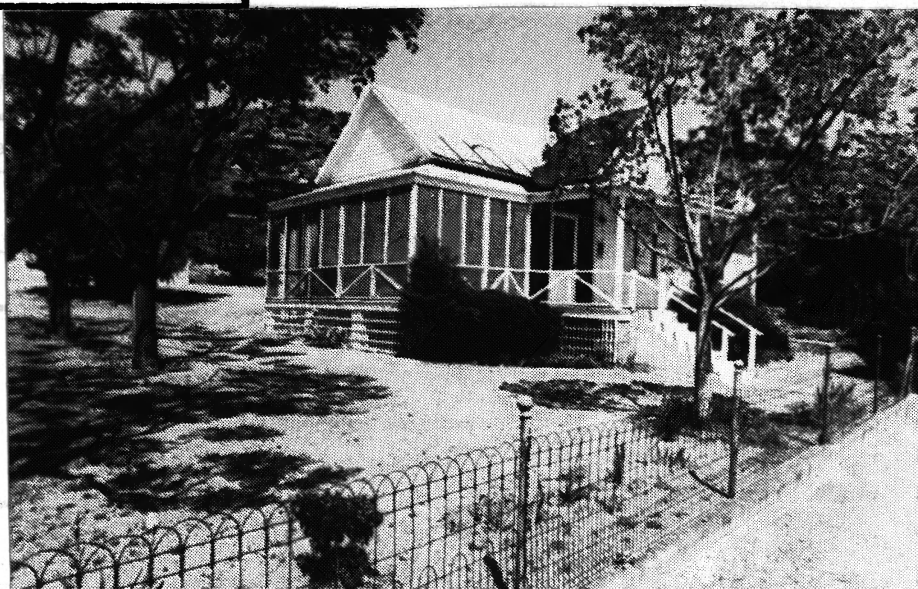

DISCUSSION AS REQUIRED:

Ross Blakely was in the livestock business when he was admitted to the bar in 1910 and began a law practice in Kingman. He served in county and territorial political positions and was active in Kingman civic affairs.

This house is one of only two remaining Queen Anne Cottages with integrity, and is the best of those two.
