Description: S.M. Taylor, an experienced prospector, had an upper Bullion Creek crew of about 60 fire fighters, one of whom had driven a tunnel with an air vent that protected all of this group who got far enough into it. Eight of Taylor's force were lost when they did not get past the air vent, but everyone else escaped with no difficulty. This tunnel provided a perfect shelter and is significant for affording a superior haven in which a large number of men survived without injury or inconvenience that afflicted other crews trapped in that blaze.

This property also is significant as an example of an early mining tunnel.
